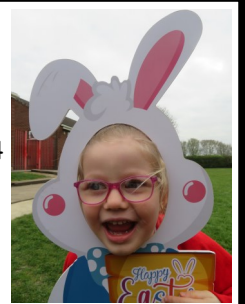
Final Celebration Assembly

PTA Easter Fun!

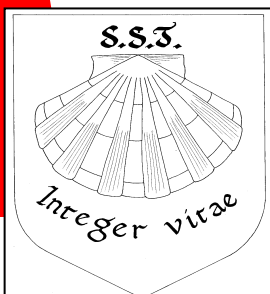
