Through scientific thinking and active investigation, children tested the efficiency of a windmill by lifting weights to see how the wind turbine generated electricity. 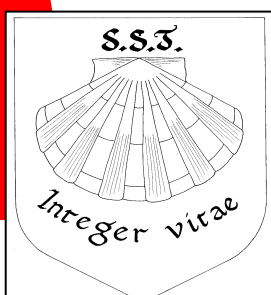
