

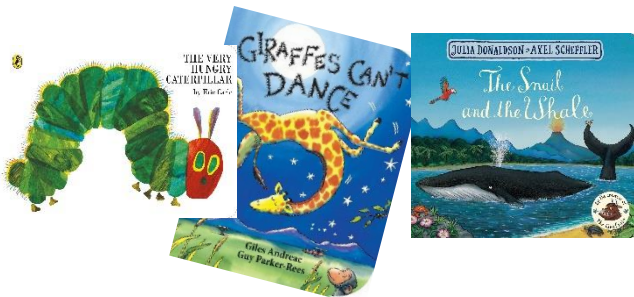
## Specific areas
