

# Sticks and Stones

## ICT

This term, we will be learning to use a variety of software to help us research, analyse and present data. We will also be designing, writing and debugging our very own programmes. We are going to incorporate ICT into some of our other lessons to help develop our typing skills; remembering to use our computers safely.

## PSHE/SEAL

We will be having a PSHE lesson every week where we will talk about our opinions and identifying the worth of all people. We will consider the importance of contributing to society. Our own worth, personal goals and challenges we may face will also be covered.

## Art/DT

In Art this term, we will be looking at Cave Art, and telling a story without words. We will be using a variety of materials to tell a story such as our sketchbooks, paint and clay. Whilst learning about all of the different types of materials discovered and created during the Stone Age to the Iron age in History, in DT we are going to be designing jewellery from these periods.

## Music

We are very lucky to be continuing to learn about music with the help and lessons from Mrs Harris. The children this term will be learning to write and perform music on recorders.

## Maths

This term we will be learning lots of new maths skills and thinking about number systems, place value, addition and subtraction in more formal methods and division and multiplication by considering links between the two. We will use Times Table Rockstars to help us learn a wider variety of multiplications.

## PE

This term, we will be participating in two PE lessons with Coach. On a Monday we will be participating in Gymnastics lessons. During Fridays PE lesson, we will practice and improve our teamwork skills during the Games lesson.

## History

Owls are going to be learning about the Stone Age, Early Bronze Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age in Britain. We will be finding out about the early farmers and the Skarabrae prehistoric village. We will also consider religion, technology and travel where we will see a mention of Stonehenge. We will also look into tribal kingdoms, their art and culture, which will help significantly in our Art lessons.

## RE

During the Autumn term, Owls will be looking at both Hinduism and Islam and the Gods within these religions. We will consider the importance of Gods in different religions and discuss how they differ. Furthermore, we will be looking at visual symbols, the religions use and thinking about what their purpose may be.

## Geography

The Sticks and Stones topic is perfect for our Geography lessons as we will be considering the importance of Human Geography, thinking about settlements and land use, economic activity such as trade links and distributions of natural resources. Alongside this, we will be considering Physical Geography, where we will look at climate zones, mountains, volcanoes and the water cycle.

## Science

Our topic for Science this term is Rocks and Soils. We will be looking at the formation and ingredients of rocks and soils. We will be partaking in practical experiments, where we will attempt to make our own soils and rocks!

## French

We will be introducing and practicing the basic vocabulary in French this term. We will focus on numbers 0-10, greetings, working towards simple conversations with each other, introducing themselves and expressing their feelings.
