

Literacy

The children will build on their writing skills learnt from the previous two terms. In the first half of the term, the children will construct a piece of persuasive writing around a film narrative. The latter half of the term will see the children produce a narrative poem which links to our overarching 'Space' theme.

Numeracy

This term sees us moving onto fractions. This particular topic will span around four weeks before moving onto decimals and percentages. Children will use their knowledge of factors and multiples to be able to compare, order and simplify both proper and improper fractions. This new learning will run alongside calculations involving the four operations.

History

We will be learning about the history of space travel and the chronology of development.

French

We will develop our knowledge of the language through learning words and phrases linked with hobbies and food.

To Infinity and Beyond!

RE

The children will be learning about Christianity and religious journeys.

PSHE

The children will learn about general, everyday safety. They will explore the pressures to behave in an unacceptable or risky way, and how to ask for help where needed.

Furthermore, we will be looking at the effects the sun has on your skin if unprotected.

Art

We will look at sculpture, comparing and contrasting different styles.

We will learn about some great artists, including Van Gogh.

Science

The children will learn about Earth and Space where they will explore our solar system in great detail. They will describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system. They will then go on to use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night.
