

History:

Children will learn who the ancient Maya civilization were. They will discover their number and writing systems, along with finding out about explorers who discovered their ancient cities.

Maths:

Children will study the properties of 2D & 3D shapes. They will identify, describe and represent the position of these shapes following reflection or translation.

The children will also continue to develop their knowledge and understanding of arithmetic and reasoning.

English:

Children will continue to develop their grammar, punctuation and spelling skills through writing activities in a range of genres which include suspense and fictional texts.

PSHE/SEAL:

Relationships. - Children will learn about healthy relationships.

Changing me - Children will be aware of their own self-image and how their body image fits into this.

Living in America!

RE:

Christianity - children will learn about the key beliefs held by Christians including the Holy Trinity and life after death (Heaven).

Islam - Children will learn about key beliefs held by Muslims; Understanding that Islam and Christianity are both Abrahamic faiths.

Art/DT:

The children will look at Maya art work and research what impact it had on how the Maya lived.

Children will then create their own Maya mask to represent a particular spirit the Maya believed in.

Science:

Forces - the children will find out about balanced and unbalanced forces, friction and the use of mechanisms such as levers, pulleys and gears.

Living things and habitats - the children will learn about the classification of living things, including micro-organisms.
