

Art/DT

This term, we will be investigating the process of printing. The artists William Morris and Monet will inspire us in the making of our own work. We shall also be considering the birds in our environment and making bird feeders. Later on, we shall be designing and constructing our own 'stages' upon which to present/perform.

PSHE

Children will be exploring the idea of safety and respect in various situations.

English

This term we will be following the Read Write Inc. programme in our different groups. This entails daily phonics' learning, with reading and writing skill development. We will also be reading and writing linked to our term's overarching theme - 'I'm A Celebrity'

Science

This term, 'Seasons' is our science theme. We shall find out how the natural world is affected by each season. They will also conduct some investigations linked to the seasons. They will take part in the RSPB 'Big Bird Watch' to be part of a nation-wide scientific investigation.

Maths

This term, the children will be investigating multiplication and division to begin with. They will be able to count better in multiples of 10, 2 and 5 forwards and backwards. They will start to learn times tables off by heart. They will use their x tables to solve problems. They will also be making sure that they have a good understanding of place value. Later-on, we will look at measurements.

Music

This term, the children will be working with our music teacher, Karl, to think about rhythm and pulse. They will be exploring the funky instruments 'boom-whackers' for this, playing accurately and in time.

PE

In PE children will be working with Mr Mooney on a variety of PE skills. The days for this will be Tuesday and Friday.

ICT

This term the children will be developing typing and coding skills

Geography/History

This term, we will be focusing on figures who explored or investigated and made history from their endeavours. We will find out where they originated, when these people were alive and their impact on the world. Neil Armstrong, Peter Scott, Captain Scott and Christopher Columbus will be some of these famous faces. We will learn that we too can do great things, if we have ambition and encouragement.

RE

This term, we will learn about different aspects of Christianity, Islam and Judaism, asking questions and finding out about some ways these faiths differ and are similar.
