

**Geography:** This term, we will be expanding our map skills to encompass world maps. We will be thinking about how to read a world map, including using grid references, latitude and longitude. Do you know where Egypt is in the world?

**Art:** This term, we will be exploring mixed media including the mixture of paint and thread on canvas to expand our understanding of what makes a piece of art.

**PE:** This term, Owls will continue to have twice weekly PE lessons covering two different topics and a range of skills to help build speed, control and teamwork with an indoor and outdoor session.

**RE:** In the spring term, we will be developing our knowledge of the faith and beliefs of Christianity.

We will be exploring different denominations of Christianity and comparing their similarities and differences.

**English:** This term, we will be using a range of stimuli including stories, non-fiction texts and video clips all based around Egyptians to help us develop our skills. In particular, we will be focussing on how to write using a first-person perspective, followed by the organisation of ideas correctly in Non-Fiction information texts.

**Maths:** We will be covering many aspects of maths this term with a particular focus on multiplication and division. We will be using written methods to solve increasingly more difficult reasoning problems. As always, our ability to solve multiplications quickly will have a positive impact on our learning this term.

**Music:** This term, we will have the opportunity to listen to and use a range of musical instruments in the classroom with our Music teacher Karl.

**French:** This term, our topics for French include 'Food Glorious Food' and 'My Family and Friends.' We will be working on recognising French words when they are spoken aloud as well as matching French words to their meaning, leading to some writing in French and speech in French too!

**Science:** Our Science topic this term is Rocks and Soil. This will include lots of practical activities to learn all about how rocks are made and being able to classify different types. We will also be testing rocks in multiple ways to understand solidity and permeability of rocks. What sort of rocks were pyramids made of?

**Design and Technology:** Owls class will be creating a Tutankhamun mask using cardboard, Papier Mache and paint! We will study real life examples of historical Egyptian masks to ensure that ours contain all the elements that are needed.

**ICT:** This term, we will be using Purple Mash in school to help us develop our digital literacy skills. We will focus this term on valuable computer skills including how to use spreadsheets effectively and developing word processing skills including typing with greater speed and accuracy.

**History:** Our topic will take us on a full tour of Ancient Egypt. Areas of learning will include the importance of the River Nile; investigating the social structure of Ancient Egypt; Gods and Goddesses; pyramids and the discovery of Tutankhamun! Can you name an Egyptian God?

**PSHE:** We will be continuing to learn skills associated with working together this term, as well as learning about the British values. We will be using lots of speaking and listening skills to develop our confidence and express our opinions clearly. Our particular focus this term will be community, diverse families and respect.
