

Geography: This term, we will be expanding our map skills to encompass world maps. We will be thinking about how to read a world map, including using grid references, latitude and longitude. Do you know where Egypt is in the world?

Art: We have two projects this term for our Art using a range of materials and methods. We will be making 3D scarab reliefs as well as our very own replica of Tutankhamun's mask.

PE: This term, Owls will continue to have twice weekly PE lessons covering two different topics and a range of skills to help build speed, control and teamwork with an indoor and outdoor session.

English: This term, we will be using a range of stimuli including stories, non-fiction texts and video clips, all based around Egyptians to help us develop our skills. In particular, we will be focussing on how to present information correctly in non-fiction texts, creating fact files with technical vocabulary.

Maths: We will be covering many great aspects of maths this term with a particular focus on multiplication and division. We will be using written methods to solve increasingly more difficult problems. As always, our ability to solve multiplications quickly will have a positive impact on our learning this term.

RE: In the spring term, we will be developing our knowledge of the faith and beliefs of Christianity. We will be exploring special places and celebrations and how they compare to the other religions that we have already explored.

Music: This term, we will have the opportunity to use a range of musical instruments in the class room, in particular, we will be learning the skill of playing a Ukelele.

French: This term, our topic for French is 'Gone Shopping' and by the end of the term we should be able to give our opinions and ask for a range of items in French. As always, we will be using our speaking and listening skills to help our learning

Science: Our Science topic this term is electricity. This will include lots of practical activities to learn how electricity is generated and learning to create our own complete circuits. We will also touch on the process of mummification, separating that fact from fiction.

Design and Technology: Owls class will be creating a Tutankhamun mask using cardboard, Papier Mache and paint! We will study real life examples of historical Egyptian masks to ensure that ours contain all the elements that are needed.

ICT: This term our focus in ICT will be word processing skills. We will be exploring programs including Office to help us present our work digitally. This is a key skill that the children will use throughout their lives!

History: Our topic will take us on a full tour of Ancient Egypt. Areas of learning will include the importance of the River Nile; investigating the social structure of Ancient Egypt; Gods and Goddesses; pyramids and the discovery of Tutankhamun!

PSHE: We will be continuing to learn skills associated with working together this term, as well as learning about the British values. We will be using lots of speaking and listening skills to develop our confidence and express our opinions clearly. Our particular focus this term will also be on money, where it comes from and how to manage it.
