

Maths

This term, the children will begin by investigating numbers to 20. They will focus on what the numbers are made up of before moving onto numbers to 50. We will also be looking at addition and subtraction up to 20 and looking at measurements including height and length.

English

In English, we will be continuing work on our sentences – making sure we remember our capital letters and full stops. We will be using the books 'The Magic Bed', 'The Journey' and 'Toys in Space' as our focus.

Geography

We will be looking at the Arctic and comparing the physical and human geography with that of England. We will also look at how life might be for someone who lives in the Arctic.

PHSE

IN PHSE this term, we will be focussing on relationships – we will be looking at families and how families can be different. We will also be looking at friendships and what makes a good friend. We will also look at respect and how can show respect to others and how we can expect respect from others.

Exploring our world

PE

In PE this term, we will be focussing on relay games to work on building hand eye coordination, gross motor skills and general fitness. We will also be focussing on teamwork.

Art

In Art, we will be looking at different methods of print making. We will be experimenting with texture and colour to create our own compositions.

History

We will be focussing this term on some of the great explorers. We will look at who they are and the places they explored. We will use this information to help us create a fact file in our writing.

RE

Children will look at places of worship in Christianity, Judaism and Islam. They will learn about specific objects and their relevance to each religion.

ICT

This term, the children will be focusing on animation.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will be learning about our senses and what they are, then will move onto different types of animals. We will be classifying animals and grouping them. We will also be continuing our learning about the seasons and observing weather as the season changes from winter to spring.

Music

This term, the children will be working with our music teacher, Karl, to think about rhythm and pulse. They will be exploring the funky instruments 'boom-whackers' for this, playing accurately and in time.
