### Road Safety Workshops

On Tuesday we were lucky to have a visit from Isabel Swain, our local education Road Safety Officer. She talked to Herons class about the importance of wearing helmets when cycling and demonstrated this by dropping protected and unprotected eggs. In Swans, Owls and Robins class she talked about general pedestrian, road and car safety.

Swallows class have their session next week and will be going out for a walk locally to look at dangers of crossing roads near school, and our three JRSOs from Herons class will be accompanying them.



### Sensory Circuits for Parents

On Wednesday and Thursday last week, parents of children who take part in Sensory circuits each morning were invited in to see the session in action. In the session, children work around a series of activities, each designed to support children to be ready for learning and to support them to regulate their senses. The activities fall into 3 main categories—alerting, organising and calming.
