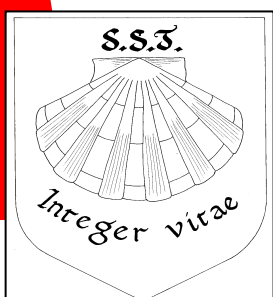
Safer Internet Day –10th February 2026
