Kabaddi Competition

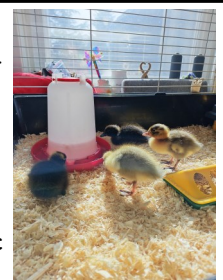

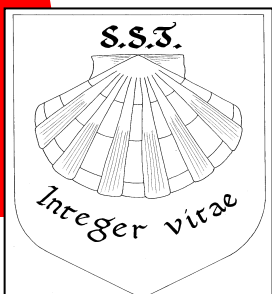


Easter School
