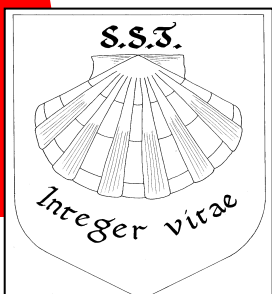
### Science Learning turns Fishy in Robins
