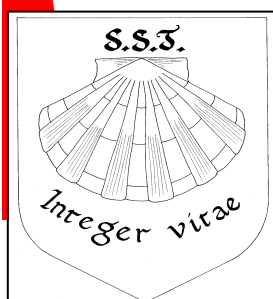
New Wrens Transition Visit
