Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

This is an online test, where each child has to answer 25 random questions from the multiplication tables (up to 12×12), getting 6 seconds to recall and input the answer. The children have had fun practising for the test using I-pads with Miss Dring, and have made massive progress in the speed of their recall and in their confidence in this area. The children all took on the test with confidence and without any stress or worry. We are very proud of you all for your hard work and your attitude towards this statutory test—well done!
