Reception September 2025 New Parents Meeting

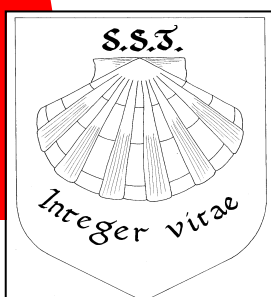
