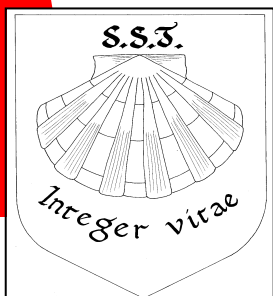
their catching skills with a partner. The children all had great fun taking part, developing and practising the different skills in the sunshine.
