Class Spotlight

Here is an update from the children about their learning in class this term

Wrens— We have learned about first aid—we had to fix some teddies with plasters. In drawing club we have been drawing pictures of Martha who likes maps and she makes maps everyday to go on adventures with them. Martha lives in a flat.

Robins— We are making dragon eyes out of clay—when they are dry we are going to paint them. We have been reading a book about George who sees dragons on a wet Thursday. The dragons are everywhere and they were hiding in clothes. The dragons are mischievous.

Swallows—Africa is the 2nd biggest continent in the World. Cheetahs and Giraffes live in Africa. On our WOW day we made things for a safari including a spider, giraffe and a jeep. We have also been learning about animals, plants and habitats. In English we are writing facts about African animals.

Owls—In Science we are learning about forces and body parts. In our foundation subjects we are learning about the local area in Lincolnshire. Lincolnshire has lots of rivers and our 4 houses in school are named after the 4 biggest ones.

Swans—Our topic this term is Fangs, Feathers and Fur. On our WOW day we sewed animal finger puppets from fabric. Our second finger puppet had to have fangs or feathers. In Science, we used different fabrics to cover our ears to see which would be the best for muffling sounds.

Herons—In history we are learning about the Maya civilisation. The Maya people wore masks and they used cloths as clothes. In 1519AD the Maya were discovered by the Spanish who found their settlements in Central America.

Spotlight on PE

Find out what skills the children in each class are working on in PE.

Wrens— In swimming we jumped in the big pool to Miss Willows and some of us stayed in the big pool to swim with floats. In our PE lesson we have been practising our jumping skills, doing big jumps.

Robins—We have been throwing balls, frisbees and beanbags into targets of different sizes which are on the ground. We have been doing jumping over skipping ropes too.

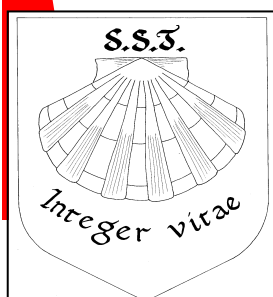
Swallows—We have been throwing and catching tennis balls. We have also been balancing balls and practising our bowling skills.

Owls— In our PE lessons, we did golf and rounders. In golf we were using putters to hit the ball into a target. In rounders lots of us had a go at bowling, hitting and running. We are going to use these skills to play a game later in the term.

Swans— This term, we are learning how to stand and position our bodies when we are preparing to hit a golf ball. We are learning how to use different clubs to make the ball go in different directions—different shapes makes the ball go in different directions.
