of the English curriculum, and developing essential life skills in communication. Thank you to everybody that joined us for the afternoon—we hope that you enjoyed our performance!



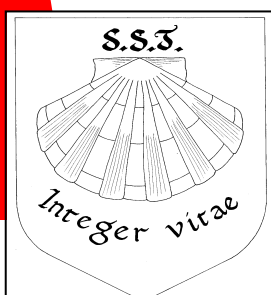
Wow Day!
