Robins visit to the Parish Church

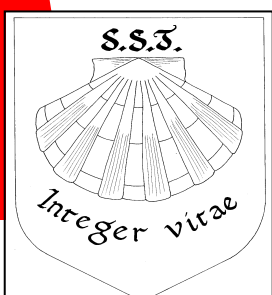
