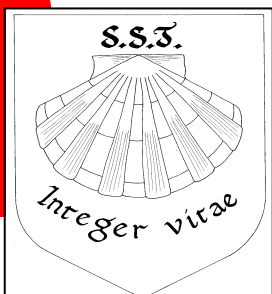


P.T.A. Annual General Meeting
