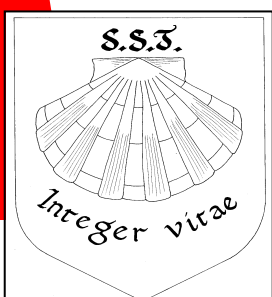
Swans Science Visit
