They met the staff who walked them across the fields and through the village, pointing out which families they would be staying with and the houses that they lived in. Later in the day the children arrived at the school room, where they took part in a lesson learning about propaganda, and had a go at using ink dip pens to do their hand-writing. At lunch time, the children ate their packed lunch which they had all made the day before, comprising of jam or spam sandwiches, an apple or pear, a slice of tea fruit loaf, a digestive or custard cream biscuit and as a treat a mint humbug! Thank you to Mr Richardson for organising this visit and to parents for the fabulous costumes you provided for your children to help them to get into the role of an evacuee.



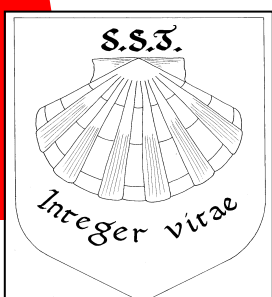
### WAC Club—Delicious Spooky Halloween Activity
