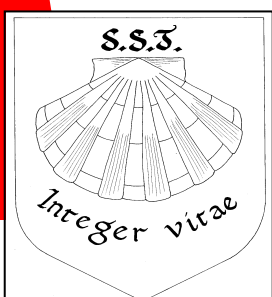
A delicious start in Swallows
